Prof. Sanjay Kathuria is a distinguished economist with over four decades of experience in economic development, geoeconomics, trade, globalization, industrial policy, competitiveness, and gender issues, with a strong focus on South Asia. Earlier, he spent 27 years at the World Bank as Lead Economist, working across South Asia, Latin America, and Eastern Europe. He holds a PhD in Economics from Oxford University, with prior training at St. Stephen’s College and the Delhi School of Economics.
